AN INDEX TO ROBINSON JEFFERS' PUBLISHED POEMS, THEIR FIRST APPEARANCES, AND A DIRECTORY TO THEIR MANUSCRIPTS

The following index and directory attempts to offer a complete alphabetic listing of Jeffers' published poems. It locates the manuscript and/or typescript, and gives a brief annotation on number of pages and facts of revision. As a research tool it is no doubt imperfect in this form and incomplete. A much better version will be possible after Publication of THE COMPLETE POEMS OF ROBINSON JEFFERS, edited by Tim Hunt. For the moment it is offered for its immediate usefulness. Obviously it is much indebted to the work of S.S. Alberts, Robert Kafka, Covington Rodgers, and Tim Hunt, from whom it borrows without making its errors theirs. A computerized checklist of the University of Texas manuscripts by Robert Kafka has been especially helpful.
