

Robinson Jeffers Travel Grants Program

The Robinson Jeffers Association provides several grants a year of up to \$500 to undergraduates, graduate students, junior faculty and independent scholars for travel to RJA conferences or other conferences where the applicant will be presenting a paper on Jeffers's work, life and times. Awards are made year-round. All applicants for awards must complete an application, which is then reviewed by the RJA Executive Committee. All applicants for grants must be current members of the RJA.

Application Requirements:

- 1) Cover letter.
- 2) Abstract of paper.
- 3) Evidence that the paper has been accepted at a conference and full and complete information about the sponsoring organization and the panel.
- 4) Current Curriculum Vitae.
- 5) Travel budget and funding request.

RJA will not deliberate on incomplete applications. Upon receipt of a complete application, RJA will do its utmost to respond within six weeks, although response times during the summer may be longer.

RJA may fund a project in full or in part. RJA does not fund travel requests simultaneously subsidized by other organizations.

Payment will be based on reimbursement of original receipts which grantee must provide to RJA. RJA will cover costs including travel, lodging, and conference registration. RJA does not cover per diem costs.

If a project is approved and funded, applicant agrees to acknowledge the Robinson Jeffers Association in all publications, lectures, and public announcements related to the project.
